Pillowcase Instructions

Pillowcases can be made of either 100% cotton or a cotton/polyester blend. Please wash the fabric in hot water before starting. The pillow cases need to be 12 inches wide (can be a little more but not any less) and they need to be about 17-18 inches long hemmed length. The travel pillows we send are 11 X 15 in size.

Select darker colors or prints so stains or soil won't show much. Due to all the blood in that environment, please do not use red fabric. The fastest/easiest way we have found to cut/tear and sew is to measure 25" lengths and cut or tear. Then go back and cut/tear those pieces in half width wise which makes each 25"X20ish inches. Fold each piece in half with right sides together this will make an 'L' shape seam (across the top and down one side) sew using a half inch seam allowance. Also please finish the seam allowances either by zigzagging or surging. The bottom hem should be whatever measurement that makes the pillowcase 17-18 inches long. Any questions please ask. No need for expensive material as they are often a disposable item because of transit or sanitation problems. Please press them and fold them in half so they fit into gallon ziplock bags.

Of course this method is just how one way to make them and if you want to use a different method that is fine as long as you end up with the same finished measurements listed above.
